<p>Toga Tangle.</p>  <p>The Romans were famous for wearing togas. See if you can find a YouTube video on how to make a toga and take a photo of you wearing it! Write some instructions for how you made the toga.</p>	<p>Roman Gods and Goddesses</p>  <p>Draw a picture of a Roman god or goddess. Add information to the picture. What is their name? Are they linked to any animals? What were they god of? Did they have special powers?</p>	<p>A British Roman Empire</p> <p>On a map of Britain plot and label where the Roman cities were with their Roman names and famous landmarks (e.g. Hadrian's Wall, Colchester Castle).</p> 	<p>A Roman Solider</p> <p>Make some Roman armour. You could make a Roman shield, a helmet or chest plate. Research the style and colours they were to help you.</p> 
<p>Fly the Flag</p> <p>Find out about the many countries that the Romans invaded. Draw the flags of these countries or you could plot these countries on a blank map of Europe.</p> 	<p>Roman Buildings</p> <p>Find out about a Roman building, then make a model of it.</p> 	<p>Gladiators</p> <p>Learn at least 5 facts about a Gladiator. Make a fact file about what their life was like.</p> 	<p>Roman Mosaics</p> <p>Make your own Roman mosaic using cut paper, pasta shapes, seeds etc. Keep the design simple.</p>
