Communication, Language and Literacy: The children's writing will be focused around Escape from Pompeii and will focus on writing a newspaper recount and a diary in role. Guided reading will be focused around a wider reading of Escape from Pompeii alongside Twinkl 60 second reads to improve questioning skills.

MFL: We will be continuing our French learning about time.

Knowledge and understanding of the world: Our History focuses on the ancient Roman empire, looking at the invasion of Britain, the role of the Roman army, religion and everyday life. The topic will be enriched with a trip and workshop to the Ashmolean Museum. In Geography we are looking at modern Europe, country, capital cities, man-made and natural geographical features.

Physical Development: Class 3 will continue their swimming in the summer term along side a dance unit.

Mathematical development: Over the summer term class 3 explore time, shape, fractions and mass and capacity. Having developed a secure understanding of place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication these concepts are deepened by more practical maths activities across the term.

Personal, social and emotional development: Class 3 will be exploring personal health and hygiene, understanding why hygiene habits are important and the rights we have over our own bodies.

Creative Development: Art in term 3 will introduce children to sculpture and making pinch pots from clay. In D.T class 3 will be continuing their learning from science about nutrient to make seasonal fruit tarts.

Scientific Development: Chd will understand some of the behaviour properties of light and the difference between opaque, translucent and transparent by designing an experiment to test the three states. ICT – Linking to their writing unit child will learn how to open and write in a word document, create branching databases and how to create a simple power point presentation.
