

Homework

Homework Books: Children will be given out a homework book on Fridays with two short pieces of homework, usually one to support Maths and one to support English. **Hand in date is every Wednesday.**

Reading: Children are expected to **read for 10 minutes every night**. It is so important to read with your child to help support and build their reading skills. Even if your child is a fluent reader you can engage in their reading by asking them to summarise what they have read or to discuss how characters are feeling or what they think about it.

Times Tables: By the end of Year 3 children are expected to be fluent (this means be able to recall the answers within 6 seconds) in the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10 times tables. Children will be given a log in to www.timestables.co.uk where there are many different activities to practice this.
