PE will be taught on a Tuesday (when there is no swimming) and a Wednesday. Please make sure your child has their PE kit in school on these days. Swimming

We have two swimming lessons left this term, Tuesday 17th & 24th September. Swimming will then stop until the Summer Term.

Forest School

Forest School will be on Monday afternoons. A letter was sent out last week with all the details of when your child will be taking part and what they will need to bring. Please let us know if you have not received this letter.

Topic

The children were excited to learn this week that their topic for this term is Harry Potter. As part of the topic, we will be reading the book 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone' during our whole class reading sessions. Usually, whole class reading is done using the iPads or printed sheets. However, we know many of you will have a copy of this at home and it would be really lovely if we could do the whole class reading from a physical book. If you have a copy at home that you are happy to send in (clearly labeled) for your child to use during these sessions, we would be very grateful.

Multiplication Tables Check

In Year 4, pupils are expected to know their times tables up to 12×12 by the end of the year. There is also a statutory assessment, the 'Multiplication Tables Check' in June, which the children will take.

You can help to support your child with this check, by practicing their times tables regularly at home in order to improve their recall.

Lost Property

Please ensure all belongings brought into school are clearly labelled so that any lost property can be easily returned.

Jewellery

Children should not wear jewellery to school due to health and safety guidelines. This is with exception of small stud earrings and a wrist watch, which must not have smart capabilities such as a camera, due to safeguarding.
